

Course Delivery Plan for spring semester 2021

after the state of emergency in 4 prefectures

Given that the state of emergency is set to be declared in Tokyo, Osaka, Kyoto and Hyogo, GPWU has decided to make further changes as listed below based on BCP.

1. While carefully assessing the situation of the novel coronavirus disease (Covid-19) and practicing thorough prevention measures, GPWU hold all classes in-person as a matter of principle.
2. If in case there is contagion on a teacher, or someone who has had close contact, her or his classes will be canceled for a certain period of time. In this case, make-up classes are required.
3. GPWU doesn't hold any hybrid classes in principle.
4. Registration for each class is at most 50 % of capacity. If there are many students who want register a class over the capacity, the limitation of the number will be set.
5. If a student has an underlying medical problem or worries about in-person classes, she should consult with the person in charge in the office.
6. Wear a mask in classes. Sanitize your hands and what you have used such as desks and computers. Teachers and students may wear face shields if it is needed.
7. If the COVID-19 situation worsens, GPWU will consider holding classes mainly online.
